Since there are four verse lines including the bridge, the main pattern will shift off and back *twice*, which evens out.

During the solos in the last verse, at the bridge, it's appropirate to play just Phrase A of the Main Pattern, lead into final line with a Break. **Djun/Taiko / Bell / Clave** on Page 2 ▼

During the solos in the last verse, at the bridge, Djuns/Taiko can play the D/T main pattern.

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
